

The College recognises that:

It owes all students a duty of care to take reasonable measures to protect them from reasonably foreseeable risks of injury

It owes a duty to take reasonable care that any student (and other persons) on the premises will not be injured or damaged because of the state of the premises, including things done or omitted to be done to the premises

It owes a duty to take reasonable precautions to prevent the abuse of a child by an individual associated with the College while the child is under the care, supervision or authority of the College; and

Different and sometimes greater measures may need to be taken for younger students or students with disabilities to discharge this duty of care.

3. SCOPE

This Policy applies to all College activities and locations where children are under the care and supervision of the College. This applies to both the physical and virtual environments.

This Policy applies to all College employees (partners in mission), Jesuits, directors, students, parents and guardians, third party service providers, v3 EMC /Sp1n4(e)9(e)9(e)9(e)9(e)
